



PERTH DOO'COT CRICKET CLUB PLAYER CHARTER

As part of membership of Perth Doo'cot Cricket Club (PDCC), all senior players commit at all times to following these guidelines to the best of their ability:

General

- Acquaint themselves and adhere to the CS Code of Conduct, the Spirit of Cricket Preamble and PDCC's own Conduct, Equality and Child Protection Policies.
- Treat everyone equally and do not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief.
- Bear in mind any player U-18 is regarded as a "child" under Safe Hands/Child Protection policies.
- Show respect for team-mates, opponents and Umpires at all times.
- Do not engage in any activity that would damage the reputation of PDCC including Social Media.
- Make PDCC a welcoming Club for newcomers and treat the facility with care and respect.
- Ensure arrangements in place for payment of Membership Subs by 30th April each season.
- Support wherever possible Club Social and Fundraising initiatives

Training/Availability/Selection

- Wherever possible, aim to attend one Training Session per week. Captains will take account of individual circumstances but would emphasise that commitment to training and developing a culture of quality training sessions is crucial to match performance, standards, competition for places and player retention.
- Support the Coaches and Captains in their plans for Training Sessions. They in turn should be open to suggestions from players who may wish to work on individual areas of their game.
- Help with pre and post-training tasks – cage, bowling machine, club kit locked away, Pavilion secured.
- Players are responsible for indicating their availability for matches at the earliest opportunity. Teams are selected by 9pm on Thu evenings.
- Unless in exceptional circumstances and with prior agreement of Captains, players should play for selected XI – whether home or away.
- Any issues regarding selection can be raised with Team Captains.
- In the event of unavailability after selection, please make Team Captain aware as soon as possible

Game Day

- Meet at appointed time unless agreed with Captain. This will enable full game prep - covers, Warm-Ups.
- Players should accept Captain's decisions on the field. Any issues can be raised afterwards.
- Play as a team – no arguing with team-mates and ensure "banter" is appropriate and not personal
- Umpire's decision is final – only thing to be achieved by disputing it is a suspension!
- If game does not have match officials, players should take turns in scoring, umpiring, operating scoreboard. When umpiring, do so fairly and without favour.
- At end of game, shake hands with opponents and assist with any post-match tasks. Anyone requiring to leave early should agree this with Captain.
- Enjoy your game of cricket and enjoy representing PDCC.
